

Needle Craft Club

The Needle Craft Club is continuing at Tubbenden Primary School and is open to children in **Yr 3 to Yr6.**

Skills are developed progressively each week, giving children the opportunity to explore a wide range of high-quality fabrics and haberdashery. They will learn how to cut out patterns and master simple hand-sewing techniques and stitches. Projects are tailored to each child's interests and abilities. To gain the most from the club and successfully complete their final project, regular attendance is encouraged. Needle Craft Club is ideal for children who enjoy art and love creative, hands-on activities.

This term, children can choose from a variety of projects ranging from simple to more challenging designs. Options include **tablecloth embroidery**, **pencil case decoration** or **cushion decoration**. We will also continue introducing and developing **crochet skills** using both hands and a crochet hook.
